APPROVAL OF AGENDA: The agenda was presented –first by Sherry Thompson, second by Josh Patterson, vote was unanimous.


MINUTES January 27: Sherry Thompson made a motion to approve the 27 January minutes as written and was seconded by Josh Patterson. The vote was unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:


NEW BUSINESS:

- City council had two new businesses attend with requests to open in the city limits of Roberta. LaPatrona Restaurant on Rucker St, Cuban and Mexican food operating hours 11:00 – 9:00 daily. Josh Patterson made a motion to approve the new business with a second by Robert Cody. The vote was unanimous.
- The second business requesting to open is Lot 77 Auction House at 18 Wright Ave, their operation hours will be the First and Third Thursday each month beginning March 6. Brant Bailey made a motion to approve the new business. Robert Cody made a second. The vote was unanimous.
- The High School Lift station is needing repair. Estimate was received of around \$11,000.00 to repair the Rotator Assembly, Patterson made a motion to accept the estimate with Bailey giving a second. The vote was unanimous with the funds to be taken from the tank account.
- Jeff Harrison is to gather all of the old equipment that is no longer in use to be listed for sealed bid on Gov Deals. These items consist of: dump truck, spreader, disc plow, chipper, John Deere mower. The police department will list the unused Taurus.
- Weapons-Chief Matthews brought before council the bids received for the purchase of hand guns and rifles. The bids were from GT Distributors at \$19543.08 and AmChar Wholesale at \$21155.48. Council voted to go with GT Distributors, Patterson made a motion, Thompson seconded. The vote was unanimous.


