**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** The agenda was presented –first by Robert Cody, second by Sherry Thompson, vote was unanimous.

**MINUTES March 17:** Sherry Thompson made a motion to approve the 17 March minutes as written and was seconded by Will Carroll. The vote was unanimous.

**OLD BUSINESS:**


- Survey: The company has completed the survey to possibly run the gravity fed water process for the HS lift station. The results were not adequate for what we need. Jeff was asked to see what it would be to get pump repaired and what it would cost to purchase new. Tabled until April meeting.

**NEW BUSINESS:**


- The truck Freddie drives is experiencing an issue with the starter. Jeff was asked to take the truck to be checked out by Tri-Sport.
- Pete Gilesie requested use of the park for their annual car show on September 20. Motion made by Josh Patterson and seconded by Sherry Thompson to approve. Unanimous vote.
- Bonnie Price sent in a request to hold monthly Market in the Park on the third Saturday of each month from June-October to offer vendors of produce, home made crafts and food trucks. September will not be available, other dates are approved with a motion from Will Carroll seconded by Sherry Thompson. The vote was unanimous.
- Council was presented with the idea of making the lane that runs behind the Farm Bureau and 4-H offices into a regular city street. To be able to use any grant funding to pave it we need to have it listed as a road with DOT. The suggested name is 4-H Lane. Once the property is deemed as city property we can proceed. Tabled until further information is available.
- Request from residents on Seagler Rd to install another speed bump. This one is to be at the end near Hwy 128. A motion was made by Josh Patterson and seconded by Sherry Thompson. The vote was unanimous.

- The Department of Revenue was in town and citations were issued to three stores inside the city limits for selling alcohol to persons under the age of 21. Store owners are to report to court June 9, council will review the fines in the May council meeting.
- Council agreed it was time to hire another full-time police officer. With officer Chidester needing more time off the need is increasing for more than the part-time employees can cover. A motion was made by Josh Patterson and seconded by Sherry Thompson to post the position. Vote was unanimous


With no further business a motion was made by Robert Cody to adjourn, a second was made by Will Carroll at 7:30 pm. The vote was unanimous.






