OLD BUSINESS:

- Lift Station, was tabled from April meeting. The bid to put in a new pump is \$19,000, to rebuild the current one is \$7800. The motion was made to rebuild by Sherry Thompson and seconded by Robert Cody. The vote was unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS:



- Equipment Sale: The city received bids for equipment that was no longer used by the city, ads were run in the GA Post and on Facebook requesting bids. Bids were opened at the May 19 meeting.


Remaining items, spreader truck, generator and bush hog need to be listed again.

- Citations issued by the DOR for selling alcohol to under age customer fines need to be adjusted. The council wants to make the fines a three tier fine. 1st offense \$2500, 2nd offense \$5000 and pull license for 6 months, 3rd offense \$10,000 and pull license indefinitely. – Motion by Bant Bailey, 2nd by Sherry Thompson, vote was unanimous. *Note* Must run by attorney for confirmation.
- Bonnie Price attended the meeting to introduce herself to council since she was not here when her application for using the park for “Market in the Park” was presented. Suggestions were made by council to name the monthly event City Of Roberta Market in the Park. It was advised to talk to our attorney to be sure this was a viable use of the park. Any fees collected by the event will be used to maintain the park. The city will provide trash cans for the events and the restrooms at the chamber of commerce will be open for use during the events.


With no further business a motion was made by Brant Bailey to adjourn, a second was made by Sherry Thompson at 7:30 pm. The vote was unanimous.




