MINUTES May 19: Sherry Thompson made a motion to approve the 19 May minutes as written and was seconded by Robert Cody. The vote was unanimous.


INCOMING NEW BUSINESS: Mexican restaurant Bamba Mexican Grill – Set to open August 1, hours 11:00-9:00

OLD BUSINESS:


NEW BUSINESS:

- Rich Sharon was present to discuss the city taking over the one weather siren in the city. The siren equipment would be brought to city hall, and all maintenance of the siren will be handled by the city. A motion was made by Brant Bailey to accept the siren and the equipment Robert Cody seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous.
- T-SPLOST is coming up for vote. Council had to record the projects for the current T-SPLOST balance and any projects for a new T-SPLOST should it pass. KRCB Lane, McCrary Ave., Wright Ave. (the part behind DG), Manor St. and both parts of Andrews Dr. were chosen to be considered for paving or overlay. Quotes will be requested for these and ones previously discussed.


