
OLD BUSINESS:

No old business to report on.


NEW BUSINESS:

- The men’s restroom at city hall has some leaks that could be a hazard, council agreed to get bids for the repair. These bids will be presented at the October council meeting.


With no further business a motion was made by Robert Cody to adjourn, a second was made by Sherry Thompson at 6:25 pm. The vote was unanimous.


