


An Ordinance to Amend
the City Charter of Roberta,
Georgia, to Increase the
Fines and Penalties that
May Be Imposed by the
Mayor's Court

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of Roberta, Georgia, pursuant to the Home Rule Provisions of Article 9, Section 2, Paragraph 2, of the Constitution of the State of Georgia and Section 36-35-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, that Section 4.12(A) of the Charter of Roberta, Georgia, be amended to increase the fines and penalties which may be imposed by the Mayor's Court so that after the second adoption of this ordinance, said Section 4.12(A) shall read as follows:


The Mayor's Court shall try and punish for crimes against the City of Roberta and for violation of its ordinances and for violations of state law over which jurisdiction has been granted to municipal courts by law. The Mayor's Court shall have authority to punish those in its presence for contempt, provided that such punishment shall not exceed \$100.00 or ten (10) days in jail. The Mayor's Court may fix punishment for offenses within its jurisdiction; provided, however, that such punishment shall not exceed a fine of \$1000.00 or imprisonment for six (6) months, or both. As an alternative to fine or imprisonment, the Mayor's Court may sentence any offender upon conviction to labor in a city work gang or on the streets, sidewalks, squares or other public works for a period not exceeding 30 days.

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor and Council of the City of Roberta, Georgia, will consider the adoption of an ordinance amending the charter of the City of Roberta to increase the maximum fine that may be imposed by the Mayor's Court from \$500.00 to \$1000.00 and by increasing the maximum term of imprisonment from 90 days to six (6) months.
