APPROVAL OF AGENDA: The agenda was presented and a motion was made by Robert Cody to accept, second by Brant Bailey, vote was unanimous.


MINUTES December 15: Will Carroll made a motion to approve the December 15 minutes as written and was seconded Robert Cody. The vote was unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:


NEW BUSINESS:

- WindPhone Update – Monica Miller gave an update on the phone booth to be placed in the park – it is expected to be in place between April and May and a date will be set to have announcement.
- Equipment Purchase/Sell- The excavator that was replaced, trailer and one police car need to be sold. There has been one offer for the excavator, however we want to try to sell outright first. 2017 E26 Bobcat with 2 buckets, 100 hours, no def and open cab. Reserve \$18k.
Streets department needs a fuel tank for the truck. When the fuel tanks are down at the county we have no way to fill up the generator. 75 gallon tank \$2000.00 Motion made by Robert Cody and second by Will Carroll the vote was unanimous.




