PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

INVOCATION: An invocation was given by Robert Cody.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: The agenda was presented, and addition was requested, Mr. Tom Sloop, and a motion was made by Will Carroll to accept with the addition, second by Robert Cody, vote was unanimous.

MINUTES January 19: Minutes were presented – A motion was made by Will Carroll to accept and a second was made by Sherry Thompson, the vote was unanimous.

February 16: Minutes were presented – A motion was made by Sherry Thompson to accept and a second was made by Robert Cody, the vote was unanimous.

INCOMING NEW BUSINESS: Ms. Taylor Stickler from the Local Gym was present requesting approval of business license to open a gym. A motion was made by Sherry Thompson to accept and seconded by Brant Bailey. Vote was unanimous.


OLD BUSINESS: None to discuss

NEW BUSINESS:


- PIPP – Ms. Ayers and Ms. Harris gave an update on how PIPP has been working in our community and the dates of upcoming projects. Dr. Woodson sent word that CCFC would be providing hygiene kits and they will have the summer feeding program through the Crawford County Elementary School.
- Roof and window leaks at Recycling Center – City clerk asked to get quotes for repairs to these items.
- Banner Brackets – Hometown Hero banners have been ordered. Brackets to hang the banners, a quote from Display Sales of \$3037.38 was presented. Brant Bailey made a motion to accept the bid, a second was made by Robert Cody, the vote was unanimous.
- Street Repairs – N Matthews at Andrews Dr. and lifting the manhole ring on E Agency St and Kirby. One quote received from Sam Hall & Sons \$9500.00. Council wants more bids, the funds to pay will come from T-SPLOST.
- Easements and Outfalls – T-SPLOST project needs bids to get the project started. Jeff to provide a scope of work.

- Mr. Tom Sloope from Carter & Sloope Engineering was present to give information on two funding opportunities that will be available for FY27. #1 is a CDBG project to do sewer repairs in the housing authority areas. MGRC is working on bids for an engineer for this project. #2 is a GEFA clean water loan. We would need to get pre-approved before the end of 2026 for the sewer plant and E Agency St lift station. There are also funds available from GEFA in their drinking water program.
- FY25 amendments were presented to council for approval – a motion was made by Robert Cody and seconded by Sherry Thompson. The vote was unanimous.


With no further business a motion was made by Robert Cody to adjourn, a second was made by Brant Bailey at 8:00 pm. The vote was unanimous.




