The governing body of the City of Roberta met in a regular session with Josh Patterson calling the meeting to order 6:32 pm.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

INVOCATION: An invocation was given by Robert Cody.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: The agenda was presented subject blight was tabled a motion was made by Robert Coody to accept, second by Will Carroll vote was unanimous.

MINUTES April 20: Minutes were presented – A motion was made by Will Carroll to accept and a second was made by Arnita Harris, the vote was unanimous.

INCOMING NEW BUSINESS: An application from Sips was presented to open business on Wright Ave. A motion was made by Robert Cody to accept and seconded by Will Carroll with a contingency on final approval from P&Z. Vote was unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Recycle Center repairs – quote from Blue's Painting was accepted, motion made by Robert Cody and seconded by Arnita Harris, vote was unanimous.
- City Hall Porch repairs – Three quotes were received, Beach's Handyman \$6742.25, Blue's Painting \$7450.00 and Reece Construction \$5300.00. A motion was made by Arnita Harris to accept Beach's Handyman, the motion was seconded by Robert Cody, the vote was unanimous.
- Laundromat update – Jeff said the needed water line work had been completed, remaining items are for the owner to complete.

NEW BUSINESS:

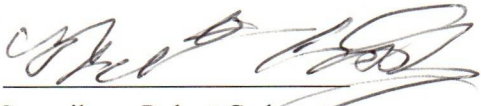
- Fencing for city shop and the K9 grave – Quotes were received from Custom Fence of Byron \$4700.00, and AA Action Fence of Maon \$4475.00. A motion was made by Will Carroll to accept the bid from Custom Fence, the motion was seconded by Robert Cody. The vote was unanimous.
- The K-9 grave in the back yard of city – Quotes were received for fencing of the K9 grave from AA Action \$1285.00, Langford Welding, and the clerk had a quote for Home Depot with the city employees installing of \$439.00 a motion was made by Sherry Thompson for the HD fencing and was seconded by Robert Cody. The vote was unanimous.

- Flock Cameras – City council and Chief Ty Matthews met on Zoom with Mason Mischler of Flocks Safety on May 11, at that time they were presented with the process and cost associated with installing flock cameras inside the city limits of Roberta. The cost for installing and maintaining is \$18,000 per year with a 2 year contract required. This was presented at the council meeting on May 18, a motion was made by Sherry Thompson to move forward with the purchase. The funding for the cameras for year one would be from Blueline revenue. Robert Cody seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
- Siren Update – Josh Patterson reported that the order to complete the repair and new products for the city weather siren has been placed and should be installed in June – the company requested contact names and numbers for the app that will be used, Ty Matthews, Kim Anglin and Josh Patterson were chosen. The siren will have tornado warnings and thunderstorm warnings.

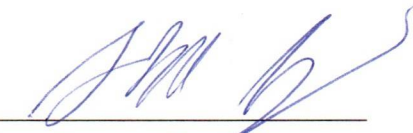
With no further business a motion was made by Robert Cody to adjourn, a second was made by Will Carroll at 8:00 pm. The vote was unanimous.



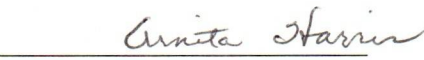

Councilman Robert Cody



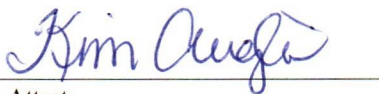
